

Prayers for August 2022

"God's Church for God's world"

The Theme for the Lambeth Conference 2022

We pray each day during this summer holiday month for refreshment and rest for all on holiday, for a new spirit and a new energy. Let us offer each day to our Father, praying above all that we may have a clear sense of his presence.

- 1. Let us continue to pray on this 7th Day of the Lambeth Conference for all the Bishops, their spouses and for the churches and communities they represent around the world. We pray for them as they explore church and world affairs, and as they pray for Reconciliation and Peace. Amen. We pray for all who live in Conghurst Lane, Risden, Foxhole Lane. In our Deanery, we pray for the parish of Headcorn and The Suttons, and for the Vicar, Revd Fiona Haskett.
- 2. Lambeth Conference Day 8. The Conference will pray for the Environment today. The church has a vital role to play in the global response to the climate crisis. We recall the prayer of St Francis 'Help us, gentle Spirit, to have the ears to hear the cries of creation, the eyes to see the tears of creatures on the brink and the will to act to heal suffering all around us'. Amen. We remember in prayer today those who live in Cowden Lane and Horns Road.
- 3. Lambeth Conference Day 9 Christian Unity. Today the Bishops will explore Christian unity and inter faith Relations. The bishops will pray 'that we open our hearts to peoples of other faith traditions: where there is a history of hurt and pain, may we see reconciliation; where there are differences in beliefs and practices, may we engage in respectful dialogue; where we have been divided in our mission and values, may we strive to transcend these differences in our shared responsibility for peace and for stewardship of this precious earth'. Amen. We pray for the people living in Delmonden Lane, and North Hill Road, and remember the parishes of Etchingham and Hurst Green.
- 4. Lambeth Conference Day 10. Pray for discipleship. The bishops will explore what it means to grow churches that are intentional about discipleship developing communities of faith that nurture Christians to follow Jesus and develop their spirituality. 'Holy and loving God, we thank you for calling us to be disciples of Jesus Christ' Amen. We pray for the ministry in and from the St Laurence Parish Office. We pray for all living in Red Oak and Hensil Lane.
- 5. Lambeth Conference Days 11-14. The conference closes with summaries from the week, giving thanks to God for all that has happened and looking to the future asking what will it mean to be 'God's Church for God's World' in the decade ahead?

Jesus prayer for His Disciples and for All believers in John chapter 17 - 'My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through the message, that all of them may be one, Father, as just as you are in me and I am in you. - 7. Today is the closing service at Canterbury Cathedral for the Lambeth Conference. We pray for the bishops as they return to their churches and communities that they represent around the world. We pray that their time together has been blessed and fruitful. Lord in Your Mercy, hear our prayer. Amen. We pray for all living on Moor Hill, Talbot Road and The Hawthorns; Stream Lane and Hastings Road. Bless and guide the Queen and all members of the Royal family.
- 8. Heavenly Father, your plans for our salvation were rejected by the rulers at that time, and they crucified the Lord of glory may your ways be known and understood today, so that people come to seek you and Your Kingdom. Amen. We remember in our prayers all living in All Saints Road, Smugglers, Smugglers Mews and Dickens Way.
- 9. **Mary Sumner, Founder of the Mother's Union.** Let us pray today, the prayer written by Mary Sumner "All this day, O Lord, let me touch as many lives as possible for thee; and every life I touch, do thou by thy spirit quicken, whether through the word I speak, the prayer I breath, or the life I live". Amen. We pray for the parishioners of Trinity Church, Sissinghurst and with St Mary's Frittenden and the Vicar, Revd. Pete Deaves.
- 10. We remember **St Laurence**, **our Patron** today. A loving servant of God's people and a wise steward of the treasures of God's church. - 11. - 14. Help us, Lord, to make every effort to add to our faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affectin, love. 2 Peter 1:5-7. Heavenly Father, you make us members of the Body of Christ through Baptism, and you give us privileges and awesome responsibilities Lord, help us to understand what you want us to do, and give us grace to fulfil our share of the work for your Kingdom. Amen. We pray for those who live in Copthall Avenue, Fieldways and Church Walk. We pray for all who worship in the Baptist Church in our village, and for the Minister Revd. Ben Gotts and his family.
